



# GEIPP UKRAINE IS RESULTING IN SUSTAINABLE PARTNERSHIPS

On March 11, 2024, representatives of the GEIPP Ukraine project team, along with the National Programme Officer from the Swiss Embassy in Ukraine Ms. Mariia Koval-Honchar, visited the BVAK Industrial Park, one of the project's pilot parks.

During the visit, a meeting was held with the leadership of the Bila Tserkva city Deputy Mayor Mr. Vasyl Morskyi, where the activities of the local government regarding the social and economic development of the local community were outlined, along with the main challenges on this path. Specific issues regarding enhancing the potential of the BVAK Industrial Park and its interaction with the city authorities in the process of transforming into an eco-industrial park were also discussed.



The EIP approach improves the managerial, environmental, social, and economic efficiency of industrial parks and their tenants, making them more competitive at the local, national, and international levels.

Additionally, the industrial park itself and several of its tenant companies were visited (LLC Trivium Packaging Ukraine, LLC ESI Prommetal and IE Rodzin). They demonstrated the results of implementing recommendations for adopting practices of resource efficiency and clean production, industrial symbiosis, and the eco-industrial park approach.

The results of the visit to the BVAK Industrial Park confirmed that the implementation of the GEIPP Ukraine project yields specific measurable outcomes, motivating companies to invest their resources in enhancing managerial, environmental, social, and economic efficiency in accordance with [the International Framework for eco-industrial parks](#).
