BACKGROUND

During the phase I (2020 – 2024), the Global Eco-Industrial Parks Programme (GEIPP) in Ukraine, funded by the Government of Switzerland through the Swiss State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO), aimed to demonstrate the viability and benefits of Eco-Industrial Park approaches in scaling up resource productivity and improving economic, environmental and social performances of businesses and thereby contributing to inclusive and sustainable industrial development (ISID) in the country.

In 2025, the second phase of the project was launched. The objective of the second phase of the Global Eco-Industrial Parks Programme (GEIPP-II) is to: (i) promote circular economy approaches in industries, (ii) to mitigate the climate impact of industries and, (iii) to help the industrial parks to adapt to the negative consequences of climate change. The programme will achieve this by continuing to facilitate the uptake of Eco-Industrial Park approaches in scaling up resource efficiency, minimizing waste, promoting recycling, and improving economic, environmental, and social performances of businesses, thereby contributing to inclusive and sustainable industrial development in a circular economy.

With initial capacity building and EIP piloting undertaken in GEIPP-I, GEIPP-II is moving from demonstrating of the benefits towards facilitating and replicating EIP approaches. The scaling up of EIP approaches will result in enhanced productivity of industries as well as in a reduction of their GHG emission and enhanced resilience to climate change. GEIPP-II is structured into two main components: (1) Country Level Interventions; (2) Global Knowledge Development.

This document details how the GEIPP-II Ukraine Country Level Intervention will deliver the expected results via two outcomes and their respective results.

Outcome 1 EIPs incentivized and mainstreamed in relevant policies and regulations.

- » It targets incentivizing and mainstreaming of EIP in environmental, industrial, and other relevant national policies and regulations. It envisions national replication strategies (including technical and financing facilitation), integration of EIP into circular economy-related policies as well as support and technical assistance for the development of national EIP recognition schemes.

Outcome 2 EIP opportunities identified and implemented.

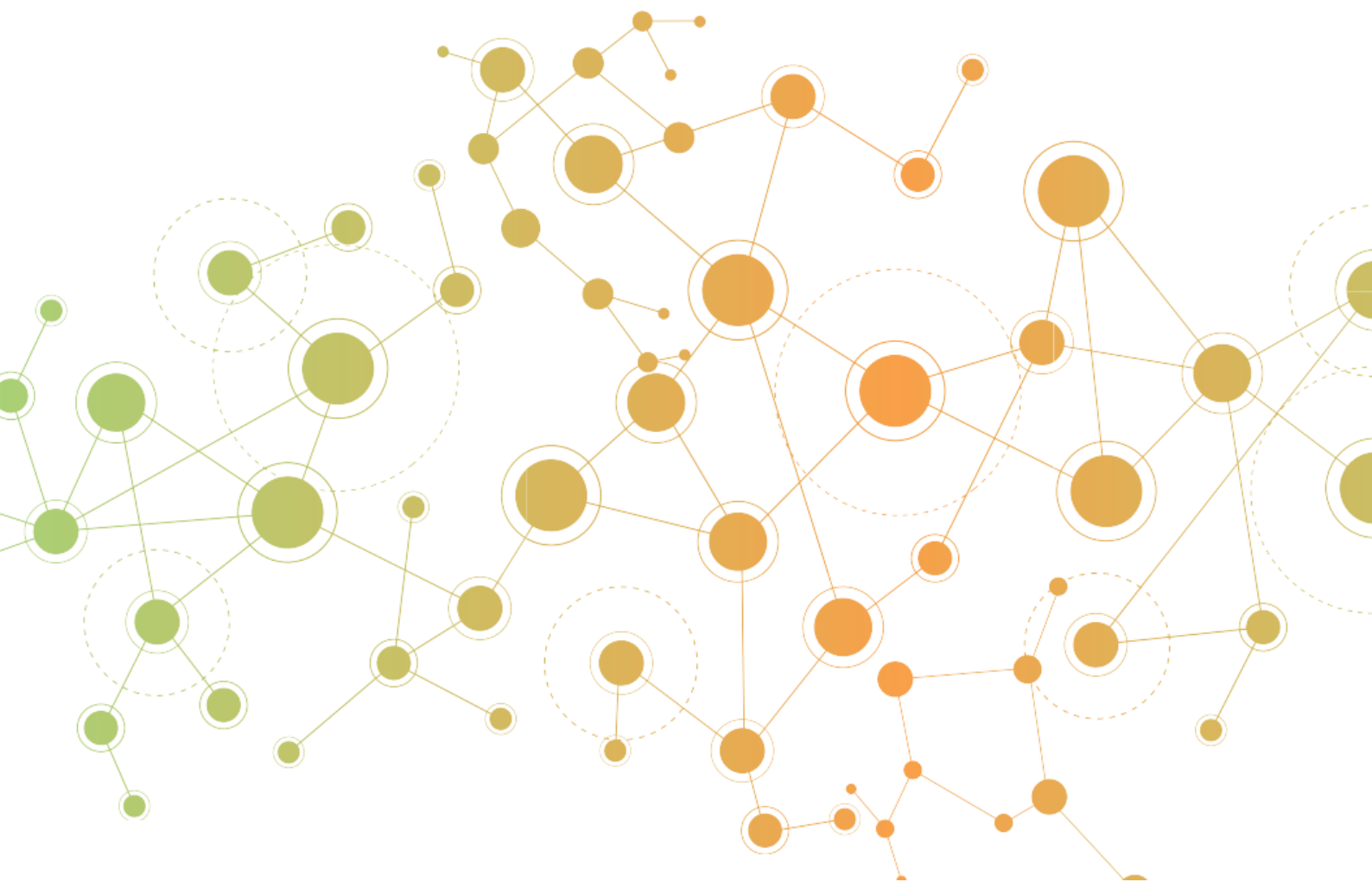
- » It seeks the identification and implementation of EIP opportunities at industrial park level and their tenant industries including SME. The scope of the project includes continuous support for industrial parks addressed under GEIPP-I, as well as additional prioritised industrial parks.

GEIPP-II takes into account the specific circumstances in Ukraine, which are a driver for the relocation of value chains along the concept of industrial clusters, as basis for IP reconversion and greenfield IP development in the western part of the country.

OBJECTIVES

The 9th Advisory Board meeting aims at:

- » Developing recommendations for the 11th Steering Committee meeting of the GEIPP-II Ukraine project regarding the needs of the stakeholders in the following years;
- » electing the Advisory Board representative for the 11th Steering Committee meeting, to present recommendations on behalf of the Advisory Board.
